



Measures against Corona-19 pandemic

Guestrooms

From the 1st of July we will welcome guests in the NIA guestrooms again. Based on the instructions of EODY (Greek Organization for Public Health) and the relevant circulars on the measures against COVID-19, we would like to inform you about the following:

- It is probable that you will have a Corona-19 test at the airport and that you will be asked to stay in quarantine until you have the results. It is possible to do so at the NIA. During this period we can provide you with books from our library you would like to use. In case we have other guests, you are not allowed to use the common spaces (living room, kitchen). The NIA staff is available for anything you may need during this period. Ordering food online is quite easy, and if you require any help we will be happy to assist you. The garden is at your disposal.
- Please note that you should bring your own laptop as we won't be able to provide you with one.
- The washing machine should only be used for washing clothes at programmes of 60 degrees and higher.
- Arrangements for cleaning your room, clean towels and sheets will be made upon arrival.
- All rooms will be used as singles except the van Hasselt that can be used as double.

Library

As from Monday 22 June 2020 we decided to reopen the Library of the NIA. Based on the instructions of EODY (Greek Organization for Public Health) and the relevant circulars on the measures against COVID-19, we would like to inform you about the following:

- **Use of the library is possible only upon prior arrangement (appointment).**

- Opening hours: working days, 09: 00- 21.00.
- You should bring your own laptop as we won't be able to provide you with one.
- The use of a mask is optional but gloves should be used when visitors need to get books from the shelves.
- Books you intend to use next day(s) should be left on your table in a bag you will receive from the secretariat. Books you do not intend to use any more should be placed into a bag and handed to the secretariat; these will be put in quarantine for 72 hours.
