



NIA INTERUNIVERSITY COURSE

Modern Greek I, II & IV

16 -24 November 2019

Netherlands Institute at Athens

Survey and staying in Greece becomes more interesting when you are able to communicate with the locals. The intensive course Modern Greek I is for absolute beginners and gives you the tools to conduct a basic conversation in Greek: ordering food and drinks, doing groceries, telling people about yourself. The course leads to level A1. Greek II is the follow-up course and starts at level A1. It expands your vocabulary and gives a better understanding of grammar and allows you to understand and conduct conversations on more complex topics from daily life. The course leads to level A2. During the Greek IV course, grammar is consolidated and conversation skills expand as we discuss topics such as history, literature, politics and more. The course leads to level B2.

BA and MA students can access to the language acquisition exams I & II and IV of Modern Greek at the University of Amsterdam after this course.

The course can accommodate up to 12 students, researchers and university staff from the Universities of Amsterdam, Leiden and Utrecht, VU University Amsterdam, University of Groningen and Radboud University (if there is enough space, other students / high school teachers etc. can also be accommodated)

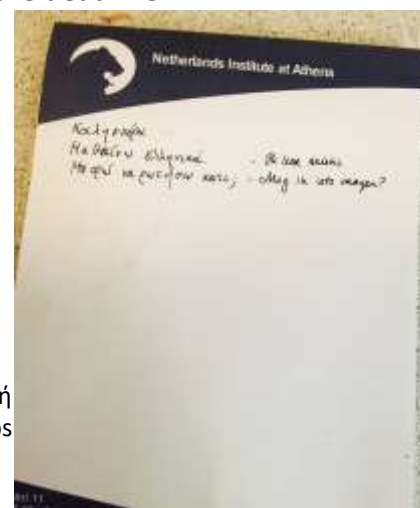
N.B: All applications will be examined and confirmed/declined after the deadline.

Practicalities:

Deadline for applications: 01/10/2019

Costs for students: € 150,- excl. travel costs and study material

Costs for non-students: € 220,- excl. travel costs and study material





Books: approx. €30,- Epikoinoniste Ellinika 1 and workbooks 1a & 1b (Greek I), Epikoinoniste Ellinika 2 and workbook 2a & 2b (Greek II), Epikoinoniste Ellinika 3 and workbook.

Accommodation will be provided by the Netherlands Institute in Athens.

Duration of the course:

10 days. The program consists of 4,5 hrs lessons/day. Students are expected to dedicate at least 4 hours/day to homework. We'll also make sure to spend some time exploring the city and practicing Greek "in the wild".
